- Ensure your child gets the rest they need to perform to the best of their ability every day
- Ensure your child eats a nutritious breakfast and lunch every day
- Notify the school with a written note when the student has been absent or tardy
- Keep all records current including change of address or phone numbers
- Complete and return to school any information that is requested in a timely manner
- Read school notes, newsletters, emails, etc. to show interest in your student's education
- Communicate with your child's teacher with any questions or concerns before going to the administrator
